LAS VEGAS & TULE SPRINGS FOSSIL BEDS LOCALS

This issue features Tule Springs Fossil Beds accessed through the Las Vegas, NV area. Tule Springs Fossil Beds National Monument was established to "conserve, protect, interpret and enhance for the benefit of present and future generations the unique and nationally important paleontological, scientific, educational and recreational resources and values of the land."

Walk in the footprints of the relics of the Ice Age, like the Columbian Mammoth, extinct horses, camels and bison, and the dire wolf. Tule Springs Fossil Beds National Monument is open from dusk till dawn. Since the monument is relatively new, you will need to park on nearby public roads and enter on foot.

RETRACING THE FOOTSTEPS OF THE PAST

Covering 22,650 acres, the Tule Springs Fossil Beds is found just north of Las Vegas and expands down the US Highway 95 towards the Creech Air Force Base. Moments away from the natural splendor, you can step into the glitz and glam of the Vegas strip.

On the Strip, **New York-New York Hotel & Casino** is in Las Vegas's Las Vegas Strip neighborhood, an area with good airport proximity. 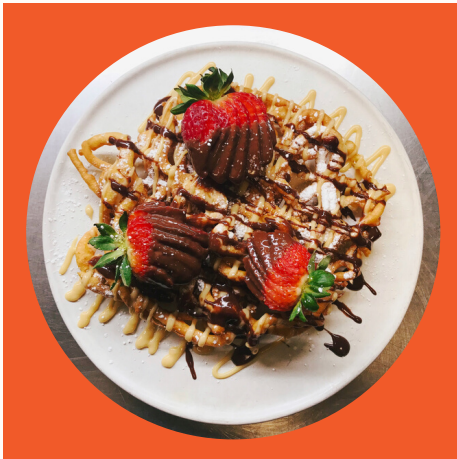
